Proclamation

WHEREAS; pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, and pharmacy students across the state contribute to the well-being and quality of life of all Wisconsinites, working to ensure the efficiency and accessibility of Wisconsin's healthcare delivery system; and

WHEREAS; pharmacists are highly trained professionals who are qualified to work in a variety of settings, from community pharmacies and labs to hospitals and clinics; and

WHEREAS; among the countless important services they provide, pharmacists are responsible for preparing and dispensing prescription medications, providing guidance on the appropriate dosage and use of medications, administering some immunizations, and offering recommendations on overall health and wellness; and

WHEREAS; according to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services, there are nearly 8,000 licensed pharmacists across Wisconsin, in addition to nearly 15,000 pharmacy technicians; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins individuals and organizations across the state in celebrating the efforts of Wisconsin's pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, and pharmacy students, as well as highlighting the important role they play in ensuring the health and well-being of all Wisconsinites;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim January 12, 2026, as




of the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all our state's residents.
