
*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim January 24, 2026, as

## LOCAL QUILT SHOP DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all our state's residents.
