
WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin celebrates the contributions of its independent quilting industry and encourages all Wisconsinites to support their local quilt shops;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim January 27, 2024, as


LOCAL QUILT SHOP DAY
