Proclamation

WHEREAS; 2-1-1 is an easy-to-remember telephone number that connects individuals across Wisconsin with community services and volunteer opportunities in their area; and

WHEREAS; 2-1-1 Wisconsin is a public-private partnership of local United Ways, nonprofit organizations, state and local governments, Inform Wisconsin, businesses, healthcare organizations, and many others; and

WHEREAS; 2-1-1 Wisconsin provides free, confidential interactions with trained specialists who can connect individuals to valuable resources when and where they need it, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, in 180 languages, and in all 72 Wisconsin counties and Native Nations across the state; and

WHEREAS; 2-1-1 Wisconsin handled more than 298,000 requests in 2025, and an additional 194,000 requests solely from 211 Wisconsin.org and the 2-1-1 Wisconsin app, and has continually demonstrated success at connecting individuals with critical health and human services through an updated and robust database system that provides access to over 20,000 services; and

WHEREAS; 2-1-1 Wisconsin also offers public health information, disaster assistance, and mental health and substance use assistance, as well as essential, real-time data that highlights the needs and challenges that individuals, families, and communities are facing across the state; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin commends 2-1-1 Wisconsin for the valuable work it does in communities across the state and encourages all Wisconsinites to utilize this vital service when needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim February 11, 2026, as

to all our state's residents.
