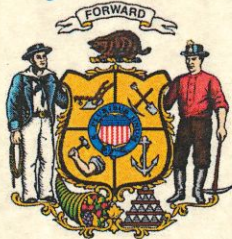


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

MUSIC, ART, DANCE, AND THEATRE IN OUR SCHOOLS MONTH


I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance
