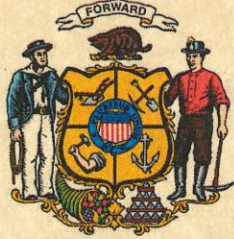



REGISTERED DIETITIAN NUTRITIONIST DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance
