WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins working mothers across the state and all those who support them in celebrating the indispensable contributions of Wisconsin's working moms;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim March 12, 2024, as

WORKING MOMS DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all our state's residents.
