WHEREAS; mothers play an indispensable role in building and transforming society and culture, moving the state forward, and pursuing a better and brighter future for kids in Wisconsin, which is why it is essential that they and all families have ample support and resources, such as access to quality, affordable child care and paid family leave; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins working mothers across the state and all those who support them in acknowledging the hurdles faced by working moms every day while also celebrating the indispensable contributions of Wisconsin's working moms;
