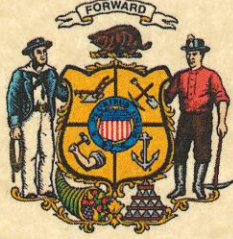

Proclamation

WHEREAS; nutrition and dietetic technicians, registered (NDTRs) are credentialed practitioners who translate the science of nutrition into practical solutions for healthy living; and

WHEREAS; NDTRs must complete a degree in nutrition, dietetics, or a related field from an accredited college or university and an internship, pass a national competency examination, and maintain their credentials through continuing education; and

WHEREAS; NDTRs use their nutrition expertise to equip individuals with evidence-based principles and cost-effective services that will empower them in their pursuit of health, wellness, and positive lifestyle changes; and

WHEREAS; NDTRs in Wisconsin's communities work in a wide range of professional settings, ranging from hospitals, schools, public health clinics, nursing homes, and fitness centers to the food industry, grocery stores, universities, research facilities, and private practice; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins NDTRs across the state in advocating for the advancement of the nutrition and well-being of all people in Wisconsin and around the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim March 12, 2026, as

NUTRITION AND DIETETICS TECHNICIAN, REGISTERED DAY

throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance
to all our state's residents.
