WHEREAS; this week, the state of Wisconsin joins the LGBTQ community and Wisconsinites across the state in celebrating Lesbian Visibility Week, in recognizing that diversity makes the state stronger, and in reaffirming the state’s commitment to ensuring that every Wisconsinite is welcome and can stand boldly in their truth without fear of persecution, judgment, or discrimination;
