WHEREAS; from an early age, financial education provides a strong foundation upon which kids can grow into financially independent adults, helping them form lifelong habits of saving, using credit wisely, and demonstrating fiscal responsibility; and

WHEREAS; each year, bankers and bank volunteers across Wisconsin make it a goal to educate students across the state about money, advocating for the importance of financial literacy by donating to schools and libraries, producing videos of bankers reading books on financial literacy, and providing teachers with finance-related instructions and activities for their students; and

WHEREAS; Wisconsin bank representatives serve on the Governor's Council on Financial Literacy and Capability, which is charged with examining and identifying strategies to improve the financial literacy and inclusion of all Wisconsinites; and

WHEREAS; starting with the 2028 graduating class, the state of Wisconsin requires students to complete at least 0.5 credits of personal financial literacy to graduate from a school district, which will help ensure every student has the tools and skills to make smart budgeting and financial decisions to prepare for their future; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin encourages parents, educators, and community volunteers to continue instilling in kids the value of making wise financial decisions and providing them with good role models in handling their finances;

WISCONSIN TEACH CHILDREN TO SAVE DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance
