WHEREAS; this month, the state of Wisconsin joins tennis players, organizations, facilities, retailers, manufacturers, and more to promote local programs and activities that showcase tennis, raise awareness of the sport and its potential benefits, and help those who are interested in the sport find courts and opportunities to play in their communities;
