WHEREAS; knowing when to ask others for help, especially when it comes to matters of mental and physical health, is critical for implementing effective self-care practices and emboldening self-confidence; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin encourages all Wisconsinites to practice and embody self-confidence and take pride and ownership in their personhood;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim June 13, 2024, as

SELF-CONFIDENCE DAY

throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all our state's residents.
