# Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; birds, insects, and other pollinator species are essential partners to farmers and the agricultural industry as a whole, as they are a key component to the production of the food supply; and

*WHEREAS*; pollination is vital to the strength and stability of state natural areas, which provide timber, water, mineral, and fish and wildlife resources, as well as recreational and economic development opportunities for communities across Wisconsin; and

*WHEREAS*; pollinator species provide environmental benefits that are necessary for maintaining healthy and biodiverse ecosystems; and

*WHEREAS*; Wisconsin is home to many vital pollinators, including rare and protected insect species, underscoring the need to protect pollinator habitats and increase awareness of the threats to pollinator species, such as non-native gardens, habitat loss, pesticides, and extreme weather episodes due to climate change; and

*WHEREAS*; Wisconsin has a proud history of conservation and environmental stewardship and has successfully managed wildlife habitats and public lands, including state forests, grasslands, and their native pollinators, for decades; and

*WHEREAS*; this week, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in recognizing the importance of pollinators to the environment, economy, and collective well-being of the state;

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,  
do hereby proclaim the week of June 17 – 23, 2024, as
