Proclamation

WHEREAS; originally recognized by President Ronald Reagan, Deafblind Awareness Week was first introduced in 1984 to commemorate deafblind author and educator Helen Keller; and

WHEREAS; deafblindness is a unique information-gathering disability that incorporates the dual-sensory loss of both sight and hearing and impacts the lives of hundreds of children and adults, along with their families, in Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS; providing access to appropriate services and accommodations, including through the use of interveners, Support Service Providers (SSPs), and interpreters who serve as a bridge to communication, allows deafblind Wisconsinites the opportunity for full participation in all aspects of society, including education, employment, recreation, and community; and

WHEREAS; the Wisconsin Deafblind Technical Assistance Project (WDBTAP), which is operated by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, is a vital resource for deafblind Wisconsinites from birth through high school and is an effective partner in helping to address the unique needs of Wisconsin's deafblind children; and

WHEREAS; the Center for Deaf-Blind Persons, a non-profit agency in Wisconsin, is a critical resource in Wisconsin working to support the unique needs of deafblind adults in living independent, productive, and fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS; the state of Wisconsin joins the Helen Keller National Center for Deaf-Blind Youth and Adults in encouraging an increased awareness of the abilities and the potential of Wisconsinites who are deafblind and recognizing Helen Keller as a guiding example of courage, hope, determination, and achievement for all who are deafblind;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim June 25 – July 1, 2023, as

DEAFBLIND AWARENESS WEEK

throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance
to all our state's residents.
