# Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; the right to a trial by jury is a core American value as provided by the Sixth and Seventh Amendments of the Constitution of the United States, and serving as a juror is an immense responsibility and privilege; and

*WHEREAS*; courts across the state and nation depend upon individuals to serve as jurors, and their contributions to the judicial and justice system are indispensable; and

*WHEREAS*; according to the Wisconsin Court System, approximately 200,000 Wisconsinites are summoned each year, resulting in about 65,000 individuals reporting to serve in Wisconsin courts annually; and

*WHEREAS*; individuals are encouraged to respond when summoned for jury service, and the Wisconsin Court System, the State Bar of Wisconsin, and the broader judicial and justice community all continue to ensure that jury selection and service are fair, effective, and not unduly burdensome; and


*WHEREAS*; Juror Appreciation Month provides an opportunity to celebrate the important role jurors play in the state and nation's justice system and to show appreciation for the thousands of individuals who annually give their time and talents to serve;

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
