WHEREAS; every eligible voter should have the opportunity to fully participate in democracy and exercise their constitutional right to vote; and

WHEREAS; the state of Wisconsin offers same-day registration on Election Day to ensure eligible Wisconsinites can both register and vote on Election Day; and

WHEREAS; encouraging voter registration, access, and participation in elections ensures that every eligible voter can cast a ballot and have their voice heard; and

WHEREAS; nonprofits, libraries, businesses, colleges, and universities play an instrumental role in expanding the diverse pool of partners that work in the communities they serve to register citizens to vote and ensuring that every eligible voter can vote freely and without fear of discrimination or intimidation; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins the League of Women Voters of WI and dedicated voting rights groups and advocates in recognizing the importance of disseminating reliable and trusted public information and education on voter registration and encourages all Wisconsinites to visit MyVote.WI.gov to check their voter registration status;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
