Proclamation

WHEREAS; surgical technologists in Wisconsin are entrusted with the lives of all patients in their care, and they provide a critical service during surgical procedures to prevent life-threatening infections and maximize patient safety; and

WHEREAS; surgical technologists require thorough training and education and live by the motto, "Aeger Primo," which means "the patient first" and reflects a total commitment to patient safety and advocacy; and

WHEREAS; this week, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in commending surgical technologists and thanking them for their service to patients, their families, and communities across the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim September 21 – 27, 2025, as
