WHEREAS; underachievement in school may be caused by several factors, underscoring the essential role that informed counselors, teachers, and parents play in helping kids navigate and overcome the social, emotional, and psychological challenges involved in growing up; and

WHEREAS; all kids deserve equal access to fair and unbiased identification strategies and resources regardless of identity or background, and Wisconsin remains committed to eliminating barriers to resources that help gifted learners reach their highest potential; and

WHEREAS; this month, the state of Wisconsin recognizes that it is through the dedicated and collaborative efforts of state agencies, school district staff, families, organizations, community members, educators, and students that the state can implement practices that help close gaps, promote greater equity in identifying and nurturing the talents and gifts of all learners, and build an education system that works for everyone;
