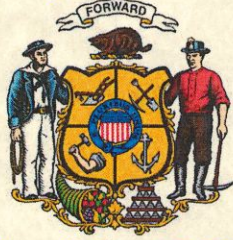

# Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; guided by the principles of the four “Hs”—head, heart, hands, and health—4-H programs across Wisconsin feature inclusive programming for kids and teens, prioritize hands-on learning in the areas of health, science, agriculture, and civic engagement; and

*WHEREAS*; delivered by the Cooperative Extension System, 4-H programs are offered through in-school and after-school programs, school and community clubs, and 4-H camps, serving nearly 6 million youth, including more than 26,000 in Wisconsin, employing over 3,500 educators, and engaging a network of over 500,000 volunteers nationwide; and

*WHEREAS*; the state of Wisconsin boasts over 1,100 4-H clubs and groups across the state, with students engaging in various projects, such as art, photography, woodworking, animal sciences, shooting sports, food and nutrition, and more; and

*WHEREAS*; 4-H helps connect young people and adults to their communities, preparing them for work and life experiences through experiential and inquiry-based learning while providing emerging research for positive youth development; and

*WHEREAS*; supporting future leaders in science, agriculture, and community leadership, research finds that participation in 4-H programs greatly influenced students’ confidence, ability to develop a positive network, and participation in community service; and

*WHEREAS*; this week, the state of Wisconsin joins dedicated 4-H professionals, volunteers, students, families, and community partners in celebrating the work of 4-H programs across the state and commends everyone involved for their dedication to leadership, growth, and the success of Wisconsin’s youth and families;

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
