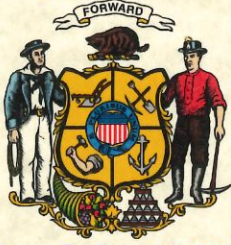

*WHEREAS*; the sterile processing department of a healthcare facility is the center of all activity surrounding equipment, supplies, and instruments required for operating rooms, endoscopy suites, intensive care units, birth centers, and other patient care areas; and


