WHEREAS; the state of Wisconsin has been proud to advance and support initiatives to encourage the growth and success of Wisconsin’s livestock, meat processing, and dairy processing industries, invest in rural entrepreneurs and small businesses, enact legislation to increase the value of Wisconsin’s milk and dairy, meat, crop, and other product exports, increase access to farmer mental health supports, and defend the state’s vital natural resources, which farmers depend on to support their livelihood; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in recognizing dedicated farmers across the state for the sacrifices and contributions they make every day to provide the state, nation, and world with the food and resources needed to survive and thrive;
