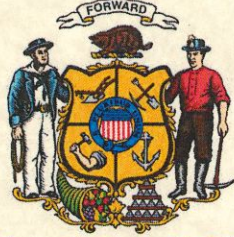

# Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; asexuality is often unknown and misunderstood among the general public, meaning that many asexual individuals may feel confused and alone; and

*WHEREAS*; like many other gender and sexual identities represented within the LGBTQ community, asexuality is a spectrum, and learning about the diverse and unique experiences of those within the ace community can be invaluable for individuals exploring or discovering their own asexuality; and

*WHEREAS*; every year, the goal of Ace Week is to promote the education and understanding of asexuality so that ace individuals feel more seen and accepted in society and more comfortable expressing their identity; and




throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance
