WHEREAS; the state of Wisconsin has been proud to support afterschool and out-of-school programming and, during 2025 the Year of the Kid, remains committed to investing in the long-term success of community- and school-based afterschool and out-of-school programming across the state; and

WHEREAS; Lights On Afterschool is a national celebration of afterschool programs that promotes the importance of quality afterschool programming in the lives of kids, families, and communities; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin reaffirms its commitment to doing what's best for kids and supporting access to continued learning opportunities that help kids learn and grow, close opportunity and achievement gaps, and encourage continued intergenerational success in communities across the state;
