WHEREAS; in addition to benefits for households, the Wisconsin Weatherization Assistance Program provides an economic boost for communities by producing more energy-efficient housing stock and opportunities that support the advancement of the state's clean energy workforce and economy; and

WHEREAS; the average family can save hundreds of dollars each year in energy costs through weatherization, making household resources available for other necessities such as groceries, medical bills, prescriptions, and other needs that impact families' well-being; and


