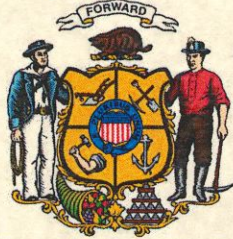

# Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; the Wisconsin Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) works to reduce energy consumption, expenditures, and greenhouse gas emissions by providing vital weather-related upgrades such as insulation, air sealing, high-efficiency heating systems, and energy-efficient appliances to eligible households; and

*WHEREAS*; utilizing federal, state, and local dollars, WAP benefits over 5,000 households each year across Wisconsin's 72 counties by providing cost-effective, energy-efficient retrofits to homes occupied by eligible Wisconsinites; and

*WHEREAS*; in addition to benefits for households, WAP provides an economic boost for communities by producing more energy-efficient housing stock and opportunities that support the advancement of the state's clean energy workforce and economy; and

*WHEREAS*; the average family can save hundreds of dollars each year on energy costs through weatherization, making household resources available for other necessities such as groceries, medical bills, prescriptions, and other needs that impact families' well-being; and

*WHEREAS*; this month, the state of Wisconsin joins the Wisconsin Weatherization Assistance Program in reaffirming its commitment to pursuing cost-effective energy efficiency practices, helping make communities more resilient, and improving the quality of life for all Wisconsinites year-round;

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,  
do hereby proclaim October 30, 2025, as
