WHEREAS; while emotional, mental, and physical health go hand in hand with proper nutrition, far too many Wisconsinites struggle with food insecurity; and

WHEREAS; every Wisconsinite deserves nutritious food on their table, and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources’ (DNR) Deer Donation Program, administered with counties and local partners, is a practical solution for combating hunger and embraces hunting’s role as a vital component of Wisconsin communities and culture; and

WHEREAS; according to the DNR, since the Deer Donation Program began in 2000, hunters have donated more than 100,000 deer to Wisconsinites in need, increasing access to food and strengthening hunger relief efforts across Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS; on this occasion, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in thanking the state’s hunters, dedicated food banks, hunger action organizations, game donation sites, and advocates across the state as they work to combat food insecurity for all Wisconsinites and ensure no Wisconsinite goes hungry;

WILD GAME MEAT DONATION MONTH


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance
