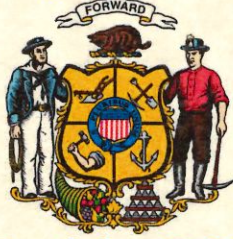

Proclamation

WHEREAS; on November 1, 1935, the first Marcus Corporation theatre was opened by Ben Marcus in Ripon, and this year, the Marcus Corporation is celebrating 90 successful years of business; and
