WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in thanking CDMs and CFPPs for the important work they do in providing quality, nutritious meals across food service operations in Wisconsin;

CERTIFIED DIETARY MANAGERS, CERTIFIED FOOD PROTECTION PROFESSIONALS DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance
