WHEREAS; Wisconsin has invested millions of dollars to support small businesses and downtowns across the state, including through the Community Development Investment, Vibrant Spaces, and Main Street Makeover Grant Programs, as well as the Connect Communities and Main Street Programs, and through the Main Street Bounceback Grant Program, between 2021-2023, more than 9,000 small businesses and nonprofits opened new storefronts or expanded their businesses into vacant buildings on Main Streets across all 72 counties; and

WHEREAS; on this occasion, the state of Wisconsin joins community leaders, local small businesses and chambers of commerce, and other economic development partners across the state in encouraging all Wisconsinites to celebrate small businesses and the many contributions they make to communities across the state each and every day, to explore new small businesses and champion their success, and to show support for their neighbors and communities by shopping local this holiday season at their favorite small businesses;
