EXECUTIVE ORDER #33

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs Employee Nicholas Janz

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2019, Nicholas Janz, a facility maintenance specialist at the Volk Field Combat Readiness Training Center, Camp Douglas, Wisconsin, tragically died while performing his duties at the base;

WHEREAS, Nicholas Janz was a diligent and dedicated Department of Military Affairs employee;

WHEREAS, Nicholas Janz was a devoted husband and father, loving son and brother, and loyal friend to many;

WHEREAS, the death of Nicholas Janz has impacted his family, community, and the people of the State of Wisconsin, who now remember his legacy and mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Nicholas Janz on July 6, 2019 in the City of Milwaukee.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, **beginning at sunrise and ending at sunset on the day of interment.**
