EXECUTIVE ORDER #85

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Pfc. Evan A. Bath of the United States Marine Corps

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2020, Pfc. Evan A. Bath, of Oak Creek, Wisconsin, passed away during a training exercise off the California coast;

WHEREAS, Pfc. Evan A. Bath was a member of Bravo Company, Battalion Landing Team 1/4, 15th Marine Expeditionary Unit;

WHEREAS, while serving in the United States Marine Corps, Pfc. Evan A. Bath was awarded the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal and the National Defense Service Medal;

WHEREAS, Pfc. Evan A. Bath was a cherished son, brother, grandson, and a valued member of his community;

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, August 25, 2020, Pfc. Evan A. Bath will be interred in Union Grove, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the people of the United States and the State of Wisconsin are forever grateful for the service, selflessness, and sacrifice of Pfc. Evan A. Bath of the United States Marine Corps.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Tuesday, August 25, 2020, and ending at sunset on that date.
