EXECUTIVE ORDER #149

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs Employee Chad P. Christiansen

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2021, Chad P. Christiansen, of Baraboo, Wisconsin, a Department of Military Affairs security officer at Volk Field Air National Guard Base, passed away due to complications from COVID-19 contracted in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, Chad P. Christiansen began working at Volk Field Air National Guard Base in February 2020 and was dedicated to the safety and security of the state of Wisconsin and the base;

WHEREAS, Chad P. Christiansen was a diligent worker at the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs;


WHEREAS, devoted to his nieces and nephews and an avid outdoorsman, Chad P. Christiansen, will be missed by his family, friends, and coworkers; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Chad P. Christiansen on December 23, 2021, in Clinton, Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Thursday, December 23, 2021, and ending at sunset on that date.
