EXECUTIVE ORDER #207

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for former State Representative Michael Endsley

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2023, former State Representative Michael Endsley passed away at the age of 61;

WHEREAS, in 2010, after a career of more than 25 years in business, State Representative Endsley was elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly, where he served for two terms representing the 26th Assembly District;

WHEREAS, during his time in the Wisconsin State Assembly, State Representative Endsley served as the chairperson of the Aging and Long-Term Care Committee, vice-chairperson of the Jobs, Economy, and Small Business Committee, and vice-chairperson of the Small Business Development Committee;

WHEREAS, State Representative Endsley will be remembered for his work ethic, his commitment to civic duty, his optimism, and his advocacy to help everyone impacted by memory loss, including patients, caregivers, and family members;

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin join State Representative Endsley's children, family, friends, and colleagues in honoring his life and contributions to this state; and

WHEREAS, services for former State Representative Michael Endsley will be held on Saturday, July 22, 2023, in Sheboygan Falls.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on Saturday, July 22, 2023, and ending at sunset on that date.
