EXECUTIVE ORDER #226

Relating to a Special Election for the Eighth Congressional District

WHEREAS, United States Representative Mike Gallagher, representing Wisconsin's Eighth Congressional District, submitted his resignation to the Secretary of State, effective April 24, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article I, Section 2 of the United State Constitution and Section 8.50 of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election shall be held on November 5, 2024, to fill the vacancy in the Eighth Congressional District as described in Section 3.18 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The term of office for the Eighth Congressional District will expire at noon on January 3, 2025. If a primary is necessary, it shall be held on August 13, 2024. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin today, May 14, 2024, and nomination papers shall be filed no later than 5:00:00 p.m. on June 1, 2024, in the office of the Elections Commission, 201 West Washington Avenue, Second Floor, Madison, Wisconsin. These elections shall be held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
