EXECUTIVE ORDER #270

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Van Dyne Fire Department Safety Officer, Firefighter, and Emergency Medical Responder Amie Sue Lee

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2025, Van Dyne Fire Department Safety Officer, Firefighter, and Emergency Medical Responder Amie Sue Lee passed away due to injury complications sustained in the line of duty at the age of 61;

WHEREAS, Lee was a member of the Van Dyne Fire Department for more than a decade, having joined as a firefighter and emergency medical responder in 2011, and she was promoted to safety officer shortly thereafter;

WHEREAS, in addition to her service with the Van Dyne Fire Department, Lee was a volunteer with the EAA and Lifest medical teams and worked as an accountant for Vehlo, a web-based automotive financial solutions company, where she was beloved by her co-workers;

WHEREAS, known for her compassionate nature and witty sense of humor, Lee was a dear friend, mentor, and leader, and her loss leaves a void in the lives of all who knew, loved, and worked alongside her;

WHEREAS, in the wake of her passing, the people of Wisconsin join Amie's husband, Mark, family, friends, and colleagues in mourning her passing and honoring her life; and

WHEREAS, a celebration of life for Amie Sue Lee will be held on Thursday, July 24, 2025, in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on **Thursday, July 24, 2025**, and ending at sunset on that date.
