Job Responsibilities

- Work closely with the policy team, legislative affairs team, and/or state federal director to ensure effective, accurate, and timely flow of information.
- Monitor and respond to emerging issues where state and federal programs intersect or overlap.
- Work across departments to organize and manage incoming from state agencies, state legislative offices, federal partners, and stakeholders.
- Provide rapid response support, including drafting letters, drafting talking points, and/or compiling background information.

Qualifications

- Experience with policy and/or legislative analysis, either at the state or federal level.
- Demonstrated understanding of state and federal systems, agencies, and programs, as well as current events on the local, state, and federal levels.
- Ability to adapt to and excel in a fast-paced workplace.
- A demonstrated track record of maintaining strong working relationships with a variety of partners.
- Ability to handle sensitive and confidential material in a responsible and respectful manner.
- A demonstrated commitment to serving the state of Wisconsin.
- A high level of organizational skills and the ability to deliver quality work on tight deadlines.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
