# *Proclamation*

*WHEREAS*; DTRs must complete a minimum of an associate's degree in nutrition, dietetics, public health, or a related field from an accredited degree program and an internship, pass a national competency examination, and maintain their credentials through continuing education; and

*WHEREAS*; DTRs use their nutrition expertise to equip individuals with evidence-based principles and cost-effective services that will empower them in their pursuit of health, wellness, and positive lifestyle changes; and

*WHEREAS*; DTRs in Wisconsin's communities work in various professional settings ranging from hospitals, schools, public health clinics, nursing homes, and fitness centers to the food industry, grocery stores, universities, research facilities, and private practice; and

*WHEREAS*; today, the state of Wisconsin joins DTRs throughout the state in advocating for the advancement of the nutritional status of all people in Wisconsin and around the world;

*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
