WHEREAS; through its national "Fix a Leak Week" public awareness campaign, the EPA urges individuals across the country to locate and fix leaks within their homes and businesses in order to conserve water and save money; and

WHEREAS; Wisconsinites can learn how to find and fix leaks in toilets, faucets, and showerheads, as well as outdoors and in the workplace, by utilizing resources that are available on the EPA's website and by seeking information and assistance from local hardware stores, home improvement retailers, and licensed plumbers; and


