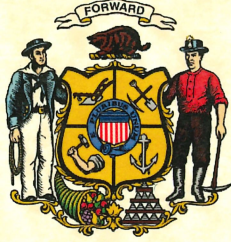

do hereby proclaim the week of April 19 – 25, 2020, as


