*WHEREAS*; access to high-speed internet is not a luxury, but a necessity, and for people without internet access at home, libraries provide critical access to computers and Wi-Fi and may even offer internet hotspots and laptops that can be checked out; and

*WHEREAS*; protecting and investing in public libraries has never been more important, as libraries, librarians, and library staff play an invaluable role in supporting their communities and continuously go above and beyond to meet the evolving needs of their patrons, consistently promoting the free exchange of information and strengthening democracy; and

*WHEREAS*; the theme of this year's National Library Week, "There's More to the Story," highlights the variety of products and services that libraries provide beyond what they are traditionally known for, from audiobooks and board games to museum passes, movie nights, book clubs, and more; and

*WHEREAS*; this week, the state of Wisconsin joins libraries, librarians, and library staff, supporters, and advocates in encouraging all Wisconsinites to sign up for a library card, visit their local library, and support local libraries across the state;
