WHEREAS; as life expectancy increases, life-sustaining technologies advance, and home healthcare and telehealth services expand, the demand for nursing services is only increasing; and

WHEREAS; while the depth and breadth of the nursing profession continues to adapt and meet the different and emerging healthcare needs of Wisconsinites in a wide range of settings, including on the frontlines of the coronavirus pandemic, expanding access to primary and preventive care in Wisconsin will require better utilization of the full spectrum of the state’s nursing resources; and

WHEREAS; more nurses, as well as qualified nurse faculty, are needed now and in the future in order to address increasingly diverse and complex healthcare needs and to educate and prepare a competent nursing workforce for generations to come; and

WHEREAS; the theme of this year’s National Nurses Month, “You Make a Difference,” honors the many different roles that nurses play in the state’s communities and highlights their unparalleled impact on the health, safety, and quality of care of all patients; and

WHEREAS; this month, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in commending nurses across the state—including primary care, long-term care, and public health nurses and nursing assistants—for their selflessness, sacrifice, and empathy, both under ordinary circumstances and the extraordinary circumstances of the past few years;
