WHEREAS; the health and prosperity of women is essential to the health and prosperity of our state, and all women are encouraged to take steps towards living their healthiest lives by staying active, eating well, caring for their mental health, and engaging in regular medical check-ups and preventative screenings; and

WHEREAS; this week, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in raising awareness of women’s health issues, working to increase access to quality healthcare for all women and to eliminate existing disparities, and supporting the overall health and well-being of every woman in Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
