WHEREAS; this month, the state of Wisconsin joins all Wisconsinites in honoring our dairy farmers and all members of our state’s dairy industry for their continued hard work and resilience in the face of constantly changing circumstances, and we reaffirm our commitment to being steadfast partners to our farmers, agricultural industries, and rural communities;
