WHEREAS; Wisconsin is home to a vibrant Muslim community that plays an essential role in forming and fundamentally enriching the unique character of our state and nation; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins Wisconsinites of all faiths and backgrounds in celebrating our Muslim friends and neighbors and the cultural and religious heritage of the Muslim community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim July 2022 as
