*WHEREAS*; increasing access to education and shooting sports provides all Wisconsinites with the opportunity to safely learn to shoot and is essential to responsible public participation in hunting and shooting sports; and

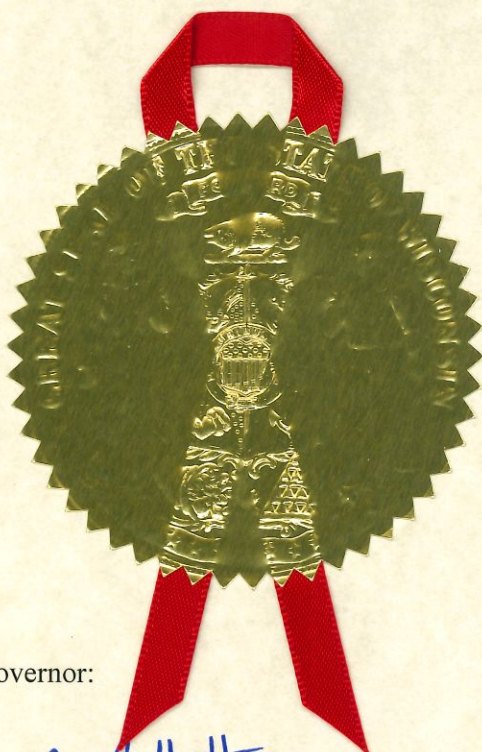


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
