Proclamation

WHEREAS; our great state is bordered by Lake Michigan to the east and Lake Superior to the north, enabling thousands of Wisconsinites and out-of-state visitors to experience the natural beauty of our coastline; and

WHEREAS; the Great Lakes play an important role in sustaining Wisconsin's biodiversity and are increasingly affected by climate change, requiring collaboration on key conservation strategies between local, tribal, and federal governments, organizations, individuals, and businesses throughout the Great Lakes region; and

WHEREAS; the Great Lakes enhance and sustain the quality of life of Wisconsin residents, connecting our great state to the global economy and providing countless opportunities for environmental stewardship, recreation, industry, and much more; and

WHEREAS; Great Lakes Appreciation day is celebrated on September 7th to reaffirm the pledge made in 2012 by the United States and Canada "to restore, protect, and enhance the water quality of the Great Lakes to promote the ecological health of the Great Lakes basin"; and

WHEREAS; Great Lakes Appreciation day provides an opportunity to reflect on the majesty of the Great Lakes and the abundance of resources they provide, reify our commitment to concerted conservation efforts, and learn about the importance of the Great Lakes to Wisconsin's economy and culture;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim September 7, 2019, as
