WHEREAS; funded through the United States Department of Education, Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP) is a competitive grant program designed to increase postsecondary representation of students experiencing poverty, students of color, students from underserved communities, and students who may be the first person in their family to go to college; and

WHEREAS; GEAR UP provides six- or seven-year grants to states, local educational agencies, and degree granting institutions of higher education to deliver support and resources to students and their families that help fulfill their dreams of attaining a postsecondary education; and

WHEREAS; GEAR UP includes services such as tutoring, mentoring, rigorous academic preparation, financial education, and college scholarships to prepare the students it serves to enter and succeed in higher education; and

WHEREAS; GEAR UP embraces public-private partnerships, enlisting the resources of government, business, and community groups to support students as they prepare to enter postsecondary institutions; and

WHEREAS; Wisconsin GEAR UP, which is administered by the Wisconsin Educational Opportunity Programs team of the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI), utilizes the priority model to identify 2,500 middle and high school students across eight high-need districts and serves them until the end of their first year of college; and

WHEREAS; by focusing on underserved communities, Wisconsin GEAR UP helps students build strong academic foundations to ensure greater opportunities for academic and career success; and


