

WHEREAS; regardless of age, background, income, or ZIP code, every Wisconsinite deserves the opportunity to access a high-quality and affordable education, from early childhood to postsecondary education or career training after high school; and

WHEREAS; it is critical to Wisconsin's workforce development, economic development, and overall success that postsecondary education—including community colleges and technical schools—be accessible, affordable, and attainable for all students; and

WHEREAS; applying for financial aid is the first step in qualifying for funding to pay for college and career training programs, and submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) provides Wisconsinites with opportunities to access critical financial aid resources; and

WHEREAS; Wisconsin's FAFSA® Completion Initiative assists students and families with filing the FAFSA®, and all Wisconsinites are encouraged to support students as they complete the necessary steps to access the financial aid resources that they need to succeed in postsecondary education; and

WHEREAS; according to the National College Attainment Network FAFSA® Tracker, Wisconsin currently ranks 38th in the nation for the percentage of high school seniors completing the FAFSA®, and 50.3 percent of Wisconsin's high school class of 2022 has completed the FAFSA® as of September 16, 2022, representing a 1.5 percent increase compared to the last academic year; and

WHEREAS; this month, the state of Wisconsin joins the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions and the Wisconsin Higher Educational Aids Board in encouraging students who choose to pursue postsecondary education to file the FAFSA® and in helping ensure they can reach their postsecondary goals with the tools and resources to maintain financial security;
