Proclamation

WHEREAS; for more than 100 years, propane has helped individuals across the United States meet their energy needs; and

WHEREAS; propane is a clean burning, low-carbon fuel that provides critical energy to residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural customers across Wisconsin, ensuring that diverse economic sectors can flourish; and

WHEREAS; the United States is the world's leading propane producer, and in 2018, Wisconsin's propane industry employed more than 1,300 workers and contributed nearly \$2 billion to the state's economy, according to a 2020 report for the Propane Education & Research Council; and

WHEREAS; while propane is not the solution to our state's reliance on fossil fuels, it provides a cleaner burning alternative that can help sustain our energy needs while we explore renewable, zero-emission energy sources; and

WHEREAS; today, the state of Wisconsin joins propane suppliers and consumers in acknowledging the important contributions made by the propane industry in our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim October 7, 2022, as

NATIONAL PROPANE DAY

throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance
to all our state's residents.
